In the men's freestyle wrestling competition for 65 kg, Yogeshwar Dutt was victorious against J Balfour of Canada. Yogeshwar was so dominant throughout the bout that the Canadian wrestler was unable to gain a single point and the top wrestler from India won the match based on his technical supremacy by winning 10 points.

#### Career:

At the Commonwealth Games in 2010, he won a gleaming gold medal and stepped onto the podium.2012 Summer Olympics (London): awarded one bronze medal, becoming just the second Indian wrestler in the annals of India's history of wrestling to accomplish this accomplishment. Yogeshwar's victory against Ri Jong-Myong of North Korea in the match for the bronze medal also earned India their sixth medal overall in the Olympic competition.

#### Awards:

An awardee of the "Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award" bestowed by the Government of India in the year 2012. Now, let's have a look at some of the reasons why India is so proud of this world-class wrestler: He brought honor to his nation on August 12, 2012, in the 30th Olympic Games that were hosted in London by winning a bronze medal in the Men's Freestyle 60 kg category. Those games were part of the 30th Olympiad. He won the medal by claiming victory against Ri Jong-Myong, who was representing North Korea. As a result of his accomplishment, he earned the spot of becoming the country's second wrestler to earn the accolade in the annals of the Olympic competition.

Yogeshwar have had to put up a valiant effort to win gold in the 60-kilogram category at the Delhi Commonwealth Games four years ago. Not only did he have to overcome his competitors, but he also had to overcome a career-threatening knee injury.
